CODE OF CONDUCT

The Code of Conduct states that we will respect property and personal rights, co-operate with and support each other and take responsibility for a safe environment. The school is committed to developing positive interpersonal relationships between the members of the school community. Bullying and harassment at school, along with other disruptive relationships between members of the school community, is unacceptable behavior and will be dealt with accordingly. The rule we follow in our school in all circumstances is:

Almanac

The school almanac should be carried to school every day in the school bag. Parents are requested to fill up the details in the almanac and check it every day for information provided by the school. Any communication with the class teacher should be done through the almanac.

If a student has misplaced the school almanac, a new one will be issued for Rs.300/- on the parent's request.

Punctuality & Attendance:

- Students must arrive at school on time. Latecomers will not be permitted inside the premises and will be sent home with a disciplinary letter.
- Every child must attend the Morning Assembly.
- A minimum of 80% attendance is required to be eligible for final exams.
- Absence due to sickness must be supported by a medical certificate from a Govt. recognized M.B.B.S doctor.
- Parents must ensure students complete missed work due to absence.
- Leave applications must be submitted a day in advance.
- If a student is absent for more than 15 days without rendering proper notification, the student will be removed from the school roll. Re-admission is mandatory if the student desires to continue.
- Early pickup will only be allowed in case of an emergency, with prior information one day in advance through the school diary or a written application.
- A child will not be handed over to an unknown person, neighbour, friend, or relative without the consent of the parents. In this regard, a consent letter must be given to the class teacher.

Health & Hygiene:

- Students with infectious diseases (Chicken Pox, Cholera, Measles, Whooping Cough, etc.) must not attend school and should inform authorities in advance. Submit medical support after joining the school.
- Parents must fill the Medical Card given in the school diary in the beginning of the session.

Prohibited Activities:

- Spitting in or near the school building.
- Smoking, vape, gambling, rowdy behavior, violence, casteism
- Using foul, abusive, or intimidating language.
- Indiscipline (distraction, bullying, etc. sexual abuse, cybercrime) may lead to admonition, suspension, or termination.
- No meeting with outsiders (except parents) during school hours.
- Bursting crackers or throwing color on one another within or near the school premises.
- Bringing unauthorized books, magazines, CDs, pen drives, diaries, ear pods, costly pens, fancy stationery or papers.
- Bringing costly articles like cameras, mobile phones, electronic gadgets etc.
- Bringing Digital/ Smart Watches.
- Analog wrist watches are allowed during examinations only.
- Using unfair means in exams-offenders will be rusticated and declared failed/ or the paper will be cancelled. The decision will be taken by the Principal after due certification and verification.
- Disfiguring or damaging school property.
- Scribbling or writing anything on walls, doors, windows, buses, mirrors, desk, chairs, shirts or uniforms.
- Damaging, scribbling or tearing papers from library books, texts or exercise books.
- Damage to school property will lead to fines or compensation.
- Indiscipline and misbehavior in the school transport.
- Stealing or extortion of money/items of other students.

Respect & Conduct Outside School:

Students must follow polite standards and remember that their behavior reflects on the school.

Pursuing the code of conduct is an essential penchant for the students in continuance in the school. In case any student violates the school or indulges in any form of indiscipline, strict action such as - issuing admonitory, suspension or termination letter can be taken against the student.

No Gift Policy:

The school follows a "No Gift Policy". School staff will not accept any gifts from parents or students.

School Photos and Videos:

The school may use students' pictures/videos in hoardings, year books, newsletters, internet or any kind of display material of Shaurya International School or any of its associate institutions.

Request for Documents

Any request for Bonafide Certificate, Duplicate Marks Card, TC etc. will take a minimum of 7 days from the date of submission of the application.

Identity Card/Admit Card:

- The students must wear Identity Card every day. If the card is lost, then a duplicate card will be issued on payment of Rs.200/- to the school office.
- **Valid Admit card shall be prerequisite for entry into exam hall in all exams.**

Parents Co-operation

Parents: -

- are not permitted to enter the classrooms when the lesson is in progress.
- who wish to meet any teacher must intimate the concerned Coordinator.
- are requested to co-operate in all the school activities.
- must ensure that homework is completed and the almanac is duly signed
- must never fail to be present for the Parent Teacher Meeting.
- should keep their cell phones on silent mode within the school premise

Fee Policy: Before 10th April * Before 10th July * Before 10th October * Before 10th January

- The Fees for the academic & transport need to be paid for every quarter by cheque / DD only.
- The late fee submission will draw a fine of Rs. 10/- per day & if the fee is not cleared by the end of the month, the name of the child will be automatically stuck off from the portal.
- The bus fee is charged for eleven months in every academic session. In case of non-submission of the fee, the services shall be withdrawn. The bus facility once availed cannot be withdrawn during an academic session except in a transfer case or shifting residence where our school buses do not ply. Six Month notice and charges have to be given.
- The fees are payable in installments as prescribed by the school only on or before the scheduled dates. The payment of the fees by instalment is intended merely to facilitate the parents / guardians and should not in any way be constructed as a right. The school reserves the right to discontinue and/or reduce payment by installment as per its discretion.
- The fees once paid are not transferable / non-adjustable / non-refundable under any circumstances and are subject to expectations as set out in the refund policy.
- Exit documents may be issued only after full and complete settlements of the dues.
- Any statutory taxes, if applicable and / or increased for any facility provided by the school, shall be borne and shall have to be paid by the parents/guardians from time to time.
- In case of any cheque towards payment of the fees is dishonoured, the school reserves its right to de-enrol the student at its discretion and levy any other penalty as it may deem fit.

- The school reserves its right to disallow its students from participating in any of its activities whose fees remain unpaid in full or in part.
- The school reserves its right to not to issue reports, certificates or recommendations to future institutions whose fees remains unpaid either in full or in part.
- The school reserves the right to increase / revise / amend the fees structure.
- Admission fee / Registration fee once paid shall not be refundable under any circumstances or for any reason whatsoever. Including where a parent/guardian withdraws the admission of his/her child or communicates his/her intention not to send his/her child to attend school at any time before the scheduled commencement of the year or where after joining the school parent/ guardian withdraws the child and leaves the school before the end of the year.

Security

All the visitors must respect the security personnel on duty. The premises are under CCTV surveillance. Parents must carry their ID cards when visiting the school. The visitors must wear the visitor ID Card.

Emergency Measures & Health Centre

- The safety of our students is of concern to us. A number of safety precautions have been taken for their well-being.
- Fire extinguishers are installed in the premises and fire evacuation drills and Disaster Management workshops are held periodically.
- A well-equipped Health Centre with a paramedic is available on campus.
- The school provides medical support in case of accidents/ injury, but the school cannot be held responsible for any kind of injury, accident in class, corridor and the school premises.

House System and Student Council

The Student Council is elected in the beginning of the session with a view of building leadership qualities in our youth. The council also has the responsibility of maintaining the school discipline. The council consists of School Captain, Head Boy, Head Girl, House Captains, Vice House Captains, Health and Safety Captain, Co-curricular Captain, Prefects and Sports Captain. An office bearer of the council must show academic ability, a sense of responsibility, leadership qualities, initiative, self-discipline, exemplary code of conduct and a high moral character.

The school is divided into four houses: **Prarthana House, Prerna House, Abhilasha House, Akanksha House.**

DRESS CODE

Students are required to be neatly dressed in the school uniform according to the timetable given and follow the given guidelines:

- Students must wear the identity card with the uniform daily.
- Wear black school shoes with Velcro.
- School tie must be worn from November till March with winter Uniform.
- Hair must be kept neat and clean at all times.
 - i) Girls of Classes I–VIII must wear their hair in two braids.
 - ii) Girls of Classes IX–XII must wear their hair in one braid.
- Boys' hair must be worn neat and cut short.
- Nails should be clean and trimmed short. Nail varnish and make-up is not permitted.
- Students are not permitted to wear any jewelry or watches to school. Girls may wear small ear studs.
- Tattoos, Henna, Bindi, and Hair Color is not permitted.
- No skin-tight alteration to school trousers.
- Girls must wear trousers with the formal uniform in both summer and winter; skirts are optional. If skirts are worn, girls must wear shorts or bloomers underneath. Skirts must be divided and fall below the knees.
- For the formal winter uniform, the blazer is mandatory for both girls and boys.
- Any non-compliance with the school dress code may lead to a penalty.
